This FOIA primarily contains photographs from the receiving lines at the Christmas holiday dinner on November 30, 2012, and the State Dinner in honor of Prime Minister of India Manmohan Singh on November 24, 2009; President Obama visiting Jordan in March of 2013; White House visits by King Abdullah II of Jordan on December 5, 2014 and February 24, 2016; President Obama on foreign leader calls with Prime Minister Mohamed Najib bin Abdul Razak of Malaysia on June 26, 2009, May 13, 2013, and July 17, 2014; President Obama attending the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Summits in November 2009, November 2011, and November 2015; President Obama attending the Nuclear Security Summit in Washington, DC, in April 2010; President Obama attending the US-ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) Summits in September 2010, November 2011, November 2012, November 2014, November 2015, February 2016, and September 2016; President Obama attending the Trans-Pacific Partnership meetings in November 2015 and November 2016; President Obama visiting Malaysia in April 2014; President Obama and Prime Minister Najib Razak playing golf in Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii, on December 24, 2014; and President Obama on the phone with Jim Simons in the Oval Office on April 18, 2012.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas - Obama Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
