FOIA 22-26844-F.2 requested materials related to all records regarding, concerning, or related to the January 5, 2017 meeting at the White House between former Director FBI Director James Comey, President Obama, former CIA Director John Brennan, former Director of National Intelligence James Clapper, and others.

This FOIA primarily contains blank pages of notebooks from the records of Susan Rice and Lisa Monaco. All of the material proposed for opening is unclassified.

## **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 22-26844-F.2 are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
