The materials in FOIA 23-61631-F are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 23-61631-F requested all videos from President Obama's visit to Buchenwald Concentration Camp on June 4, 2009.

This FOIA primarily contains footage of remarks by President Obama, German Chancellor Angela Merkel, and Elie Wiesel. There is also footage of the group (including camp survivor Bertrand Herz) touring the concentration camp.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 23-61631-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Communications Agency.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
