FOIA 24-19013-F requested any video footage of President Obama on May 1, 2011, including but not limited to

videos all taken by any White House videographer.

This FOIA primarily contains footage of President Obama preparing and delivering remarks on the death of Osama Bin Laden. There is also footage of people celebrating outside the White House.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 24-19013-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Communications Agency.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
