Message: I am writing to thank you for your last eight years of leadership. Although I am not of your typical constituency — I am a middle-aged middle-class white man, a veteran of the US Army, living in one of the most conservative counties in Alabama — I can objectively say that America is better off today than it was eight years ago when you took office.

Two episodes occurred during your presidency which speak to your character as leader:

1. In July 2009, you invited Professor Gates and Sergeant Crowley to the White House to share a beer with you. You are a bridge-builder. I wish more people would share a beer with their adversaries.
